In 2015, Kittson County again saw low numbers for loan applications most likely due to the low interest rates available at local equipment dealers. There has continued to be increased interest in Septic loans. There has been a drop in Ag Waste Management loans. Conservation tillage remains a high priority loan practice, as in the past years.
