Grant Activity - Riparian Zone Ma	nagement- 2017 Adult and Youth Outreach
Description	Kittson County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan
	Funds will be used toward the district promoting education in Kittson County. The SWCD plans to engage more with school aged children with an outdoor learning day and/or summer science day; including information on the importance of planting trees and water quality. The Kittson SWCD has not offered this type of event in the past so budgeting would include more staff time in the beginning to get the event planned. The event budget will be \$2,500.00. New education information includes family education days and Conservation Day at the Fair. These events are currently not offered in Kittson County and with staff time we estimate \$1,000 an event. Funds will also be used to purchase new display boards for education days including the fair and crop shows. Display boards and retractable banners estimate \$1,500.00. Also we would like to purchase new display holders for all our informational documents for our programs, which would cost \$1,600.00 Currently the Kittson SWCD owns a parcel of land located in Pelan Section 1 called Moose Point Learning Center. This site has not been utilized since the late 90's and the district would like to clean up the site and begin offering Youth and Adult Outreach programs at the site. The estimated cost of revamping this learning site would be \$17,000.00, this includes brush removal, mowing the trails, updating the current picnic shelter and new picnic tables and presenter tables as well as a new and updated sign. Costs over the \$20,000 will be charged to other grants or District funds.

Description	Kittson County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan
	The Kittson SWCD will use these funds to promote the district through advertisement. Currently, the County has 30 year old signs at the county entrances with a "Now Entering & Now Leaving Kittson Soil and Water Conservation District" message, the district would like to update the signs and place 12 new signs at 6 county entrances. These signs are either non-existent or are faded and are unable to be read. The estimated cost of these signs would include design of the signs, the cost of each sign, staff time spent to get permission for right-of-ways, and installation. An estimated cost would be \$ 3000.00. The Kittson SWCD will also continue to advertise the programs offered through the Kittson SWCD through Radio, Newspaper and Social Media.
